



Your support is making a difference – Peru Update

On the evening of August 15, southern Peru's coastal provinces felt the devastating shake of a magnitude 8.0 earthquake. The earthquake killed over 500 people and toppled homes and infrastructures in the provinces of Ica, Chincha and Pisco. Some 60,500 homes, 14 hospitals and eight schools were destroyed; some 200,000 families are believed homeless. Damage estimates were put at between 70 and 100 percent in communities closest to the epicenter.

Herbalife Family Foundation continues to raise funds to help support Save the Children's relief work in Peru, providing essential aid to children and families in need. **So far, more than \$48,000 has been collected from generous Distributors and Herbalife staff.**

Despite the difficulties encountered when trying to reach the people most affected by the devastation, Save the Children has delivered family kitchen kits, blankets, insulated tents and drinking water to 500 families in Ica and the 1,750 children among them. In addition to providing shelter and food, psychosocial services and activities are also being provided by relief workers to the children in this area.

In the small, impoverished communities in the district of Pueblo Nueva the earthquake was devastating; virtually all of the housing was damaged or destroyed beyond repair. Save the Children has provided food rations and safe drinking water to 10,000 families in the small villages of Pueblo Nueva.
